The Indiana Economic Development Corporation (IEDC), using a program funded by the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA), is partnering with Purdue MEP to fund up to \$250,000 in 2024-2025 for CMMC Level 1 assessments and implementation. CMMC stands for "Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification" and is a unifying standard for the implementation of cybersecurity across the Defense Industrial Base (DIB).

This opportunity is perfect for small companies, per SBA size standards, that need support to adopt foundational cyber practices and are unable to participate in the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) contracting realm without it. However, this program is not limited to defense industrial base companies, it is open to any small business that wants to better protect their information!

**Who is eligible?**

Small Indiana businesses that meet the SBA standard as a small business

**Why is it necessary?**

To better protect the information in small businesses. It is also a requirement for DoD work.

**What is provided?**

CMMC Level 1 assessments and some implementation.

**What is the cost?**

It's free to you! IEDC, using SBA funding, has committed \$250,000 in 2024-2025 for assessments with some implementation.

**When is it available?**

Now through August 2025 - or until funding runs out.
